General Rules

- 1. The show is open to any 4-H and FFA member 18 years of age and under.
- 2. Exhibitors must furnish their own feed and equipment. No bedding will be allowed in the beef barn. Sand is available in the beef barn.
- 3. Exhibitors will be required to clean their stalls and area after the show.
- 4. All animals must be owned and shown by exhibitor unless pre-approved by the show committee.
- 5. All steers, lambs, and goats will be judged as show prospects, not as finished market animals.
- 6. Miami County Livestock Association will not be held responsible for any damage to or loss of property, for the duration of the show.
- 7. There will be a Miami County only class at the end of each show. The exhibitor is only allowed to show one animal per species.
- 8. There will be Pee-Wee Classes for kids 6 and under for Lamb and Goats only.
- 9. To be eligible for showmanship, exhibitor has to be entered in a class.

Bucket Calf Show

- 1. All entries will be shown in a single class, and one entry per an exhibitor.
- 2. Calves need to be born after January 1st 2018.
- 3. Bucket Calf entries will not be eligible for showmanship.

Heifer Show:

- 1. Registration papers are required for heifers unless showing crossbred. If no papers will show as crossbred. Papers must be in individual's name.
- 2. No bedding will be allowed. All animal waste needs to be cleaned up before going home. Sand will be used for bedding.

Steer Show:

- 1. Steers must conform to breed standards. If not they will show as crossbred.
- 2. No bedding is allowed. All animal waste needs to be cleaned up before going home.

Prospect Market Lamb Show:

- 1. All animals will be inspected prior to unloading. If infected animals are found, the entire load will be asked to leave the premises.
- 2. All ewe lambs must be identified with an official USDA premises ID tag.
- 3. Official health papers must accompany out of state lambs and all lambs must be free of symptoms of contagious or communicable diseases.
- 4. All lambs must be born after January 1, 2017
- 5. All lambs must be clipped ¼ inch hair or less, prior to arrival at the fairgrounds.

Prospect Market Goat Show:

- 1. Goats must be slick shorn with 3/8 inch hair of less at the time of weigh-in from the knee and hock up. Excluding top of tail.
- 2. Must be dehorned or have horns tipped. No sharp points allowed.
- 3. May be either non-breed does or wethers. Will show together.
- 4. You may use a halter or collars when showing.

Doe Show

1. There will be 4 classes 0-6 months, 6-12 months, 12-18 months, and 18 months and older.
