All Marais des Cygnes District 4-Hers (4-H age 7 to 18) who complete the following are eligible for County Project Awards:

KAP (Kansas Award Portfolio)**

NEW! Each Project must be in a separate 3-ring binder or pocket folder with brads. Each book needs a copy of your personal page and 4-H Story along with the KAP for that project.

Even though we are not requiring a Permanent Record, all 4-H'ers are encouraged to keep a yearly record of what you have done in 4-H. This can be using the existing Permanent Record, a Calendar, or making your own spreadsheet, or whatever works best for you. This record will be valuable as you fill out scholarship and pin applications.

Member Achievement Pins

Member Achievement Pins are based on what you have done throughout the year and are not limited in the number given out. It is recommended that you look at your pin applications at the first of the 4-H Year so that you are aware of what requirements you need to meet.

Guidelines for Marais des Cygnes Member Achievement Pins are:

- Only one Achievement Pin can be received by a 4-H member each year. 4-Hers may receive Special Awards such as the Kansas 4-H Key Award with a Member Achievement Pin.
- A pin may be skipped, but once a pin is skipped, a 4-Her may not go back and apply for it. For example: If a member received the Emerald Pin in 2014 and the Silver Guard in 2015, he/she cannot go back and apply for the Silver Pin in 2016.
- Pin Applications are the State Forms. These forms are available from the Extension Office or on our website at www.maraisdescygn.es.ksu.edu under Pin Applications.
- INDEPENDENT 4-H Members are not eligible for Member Pins

Member Achievement Pins will count towards your County Scholarships when you are a Senior.

To apply for a Pin award (Membership, Bronze, Silver, etc), you must complete the following:

Member Achievement Pins

Cloverbud Pin (do not have to fill anything out)

- 1 - 4-H Membership Pin
- 2 - Bronze Pin
- 3 - Clover Pin
- 4 - Emerald Pin
- 5 - Silver Pin
- 6 - Silver Guard Pin
- 7 - Leadership Pin (must enroll in Leadership)
- 8 - Gold Pin
- 9 - Gold Guard Pin
- 10 - Year Pin (Miami County Only)

I Dare You Award (Miami County Only)

Miami County offers the I Dare You Leadership Award to 4-Hers who meet the following requirements:

- 1) Are 14 years of age by January 1 of the current year.
- 2) Must have shown leadership abilities in his/her club, community, and have demonstrated excellence in character.

Kansas 4-H Key Award

The Kansas 4-H Key Award is a state award with the basic requirements of:

- 1) A 4-Her must be passed his/her 16th birthday before January 1 of the current year.
- 2) A 4-Her must have completed 4 or more years of 4-H work.
- 3) A 4-Her must have enrolled in leadership for four or more years.
