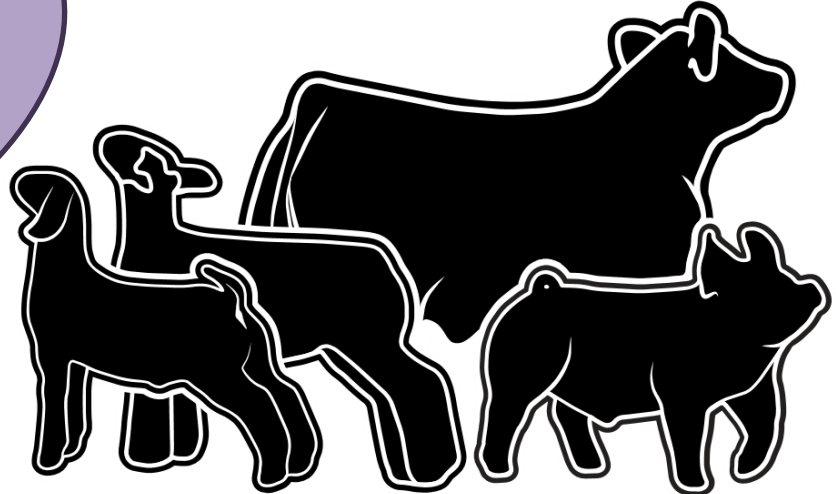

Rules:

1. All entries /weigh cards are due to the check in table 1 hour prior to the start of the show entries are for. Entry /weigh cards will be available for you at the scale and entry table.
2. Entry fee is \$10.00 per head, with an exhibitor limit of \$25 and a family limit of \$50. Showmanship is free. No Refunds.
3. Showmanship ages will be determined as of January 1. To participate in showmanship each exhibitor must enter at minimum one animal in the show. This does not apply for Pee-Wee and Clover Buds.
4. The show is open to all 4-H and FFA members. Only 4-H'ser ages 7-18 as of January 1 may show in the market and breeding classes. Pee-Wee and Clover Bud is open to youth ages 6 & Under.
5. All animals must have a 4-H Eid tags and lambs and goats must have a USDA scrapie tag.
6. Animals are only eligible to show in a market or breeding class, not both.
7. Animals must be owned and shown by the exhibitor with no assistance.
8. Classes will be broken by weight in the market and by breed and/or age in the breeding. No maximum or minimum weight requirements. Show committee does have the option of a 10 pound weigh back and reserve the right to enforce. Goats and lambs must have milk teeth.
9. If fewer than 5 head are entered in a breeding class they will show in AOB.
10. Animals will be shown according to the Kansas State Fair Guidelines.
11. No bedding materials provided and all exhibitors are expected to clean up their area.
12. The use of adhesives and dyes is prohibited.
13. No mistreatment of animals will be allowed.
14. Animals showing signs of illness, fungus, or sore mouth will not be allowed to exhibit.
15. Only does, ewes, barrows and wethers are permitted at the show, no intact males.
16. Upon arrival at the show please check in with show staff at the registration table.
17. Show is judged as a "prospect show" and the Judges decision is final.
18. Any Linn County 4-H'er needing to weigh and tag for the Linn County 4-H weigh-in can come in during open scales and a representative will be there to tag your animal.
