Exhibit Release

Animal Exhibits not going through the auctions will be released on Friday, July 24 at 10 pm. If you do not pick up on Friday evening, you must wait until 1pm on Saturday, July 25th. All other exhibits will be released at 1pm on Saturday, July 25th.

Miami County Fair Ribbon Premiums

Ribbon Premiums will be handed out on **Saturday, July 25 from 3:30-5:30pm** at the Fairgrounds. This time could be delayed if clean-up is still happening at the fairgrounds. If you do not pick them up at this time, they will only be available on August 28th from 6-7pm.

Miami County Fashion Revue

Fashion Revue Judging will be Monday, July 13, 2026 starting at 9am at the **First Baptist Church in Paola. (207 E. Wea).**

Sign-up: Instead of signing up for times this year, you will need to check in from 8:30-11:00 am at the Front Table in the church on July 13th. You will then line up to get judged. Whoever is first in line will model and we will continue through the line. If you have more than one outfit, you will change and then get back in line for your other outfits. There will be dressing rooms available for you to change in.

Bring the completed Scorecard and Script form to the Fashion Revue Judging on Monday, July 13th. Call backs are used for the judges to choose champions and reserve champions and are scheduled to start about 12:30pm or as soon as we are done judging individuals.

Public Fashion Revue will be on July 20 at 7:00pm in Building #4. Please be in Building #4 ready to line-up at 6:45 pm.

Miami County Fair Set-up: Saturday, July 18th

4-H'ers and Adult Volunteers are needed to come and help set-up for the fair on Saturday, July 18. **Set-up will start about 9 am and go until we are done.** We will be getting the displays and judging areas set up in the buildings as well as cleaning and preparing the barns for animals. We will also be stocking the Food Stand and setting up for Public Fashion Revue in Building #4.

Miami County Fair Clean-up Assignments

During the Saturday, July 25, Fair Clean Up , you need to pick up trash, help put away equipment, and sweep floors. Fair tear down will start about 2pm in Building #2 & #4. We ask that all 4-H'ers pick up their exhibits between 1-2pm and cleanup will start at 2pm. **Fair Board asks clubs to empty trash containers in their areas at least once a day during the week of fair.**

Miami County Sheep, Meat & Dairy Goat Vet Check & Weigh-in

Vet Check & Weigh-in will be the morning of **TUESDAY, JULY 21. Sheep and Meat Goats will only be allowed on fairgrounds during this time. DO NOT bring any Sheep/Meat Goats to fairgrounds before this time.**

- **Vet Check will take place from 7:00 to 8:30 am in the North Parking Lot.** There will be a designated area for Sheep & Meat Goat exhibitors to line up for Vet Check. See the Map on pg. 4! *Reminder: Please have sheep/goats clipped before coming to fairgrounds and scrapie tags in the ear, if scrapie tags weren't in at spring tag-in. As well as please have any sheep/goat blankets off of your animal before inspection.* After inspection, exhibitors may pull down and unload your

trailer. Please wait to pull down and unload until the vehicle in front of you has left, this will greatly help with traffic.

- **Weigh-in** will be held the morning of Tuesday, July 21. Please have someone at your pens who can help bring sheep/meat goats to weigh-in when it's your turn.

 - **Order: Swine, Beef, Sheep & Meat Goats, Bucket Calves**
 - (if bucket calves want to weigh)
- **Dairy Goats:** If stalling the whole week of county fair, those animals must go through Vet Check on Tuesday morning.

Miami County Beef & Bucket Calf Check in

Those of you that will be bringing Beef &/or Bucket Calves to the fair may bring those animals anytime on Monday, July 20th or the morning of Tuesday, July 21st. ***Beef cattle must be on the fairgrounds and in place on Tuesday July 21st by 9:00 am. Bucket Calves must be on the fairgrounds and in place on Tuesday July 21st by 10:00 am.*** Please follow the unloading/loading trailer traffic patterns.

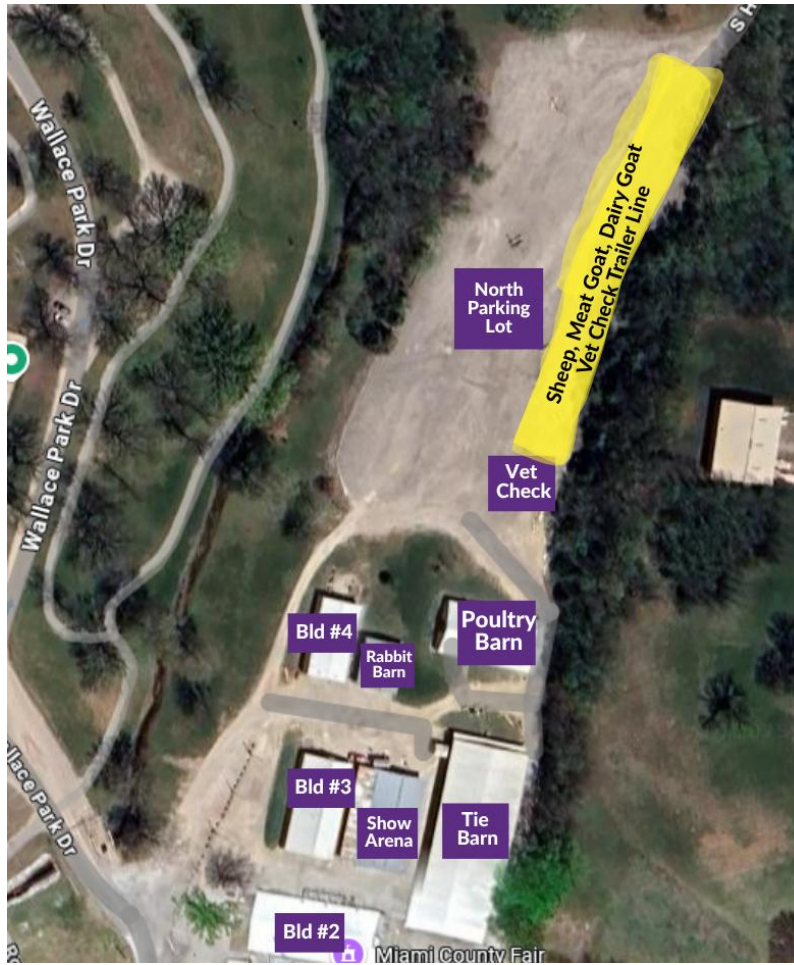
