

New Information regarding breeding animals

All breeding animals are to be tagged at weigh-in dates, with the exception of registered breeding animals. Registered breeding animals will enter the following information when filling out Miami County Fair entries:

- * Registered breeding heifers can use tattoo numbers
- * Registered breeding gilts can use ear notches
- * Registered breeding ewes can use scrapie tags
- * Dairy goats/cattle can use scrapie tags or tattoo numbers

Registration papers for breeding heifers, gilts, ewes and dairy goats/cattle must show that the ownership of such animal was transferred into the exhibitor's name by June 15th. A copy of registration papers is to be sent to the extension office by July 5th, when fair entries are due.

- o Breeding Gilts, Ewes, Does (**that were not tagged** at the May 3rd date)
- o Last minute tagging for State Fair and KJLS nominated animals
