A bit of historical information - the Linn County Courthouse building was constructed in 1885. It was listed on the National Register of Historic Places in 1974. It is the second oldest operational courthouse in the state of Kansas.

In a cyan printing frame the dry paper is place chemical side up. On top of that goes what you are using to block the sun (leaves lace, cut paper, a film negative for example). A glass sheet is placed on top and the frame is taken



outside to the sun for exposure. If it is a sunny, summer day it should only take 2-5 minutes.

The paper is then removed from the frame and rinsed in water and allowed to dry.
