The 1.5 acre Rose Garden sits in the northern section of Loose Park, a 75-acre park just south of the Country Club Plaza in Kansas City, MO.

EMGs along with their invited personal friends toured the Laura Conyers Rose Garden on a very hot steamy July morning with the President of the Rose Society, Laura Dickinson.





We bombarded her with many questions...learning about the architecture, differences in rose varieties (there are over 130 varieties and over 2,000 rose bushes), and fascinating history dating back to the Civil War. Unfortunately, we saw firsthand what the midge insect can do to strip the



majority of the flowers from the bushes. It was quite sad to see but the good news is they will recover.
